Service Project , Grades 3-8 *Feed My Starving Children:* The students in grades 3-8 have participated in a service project entitled *Feed My Starving Children*. Students in these grades ,as of this writing were preparing to participate in an opportunity to package meals on September 18, at Brookfield Lutheran Church, that will eventually be delivered to children in need all around the world. Volunteers hand pack meals for children to be sent to more than 60 countries. These volunteers measure ingredients, pack food and prepare boxes for shipments. More than half of the volunteers are under 18 years of age. The 515 volunteers packed a total of 478 boxes of meals. Those 478 boxes contained 103,248 meals.
